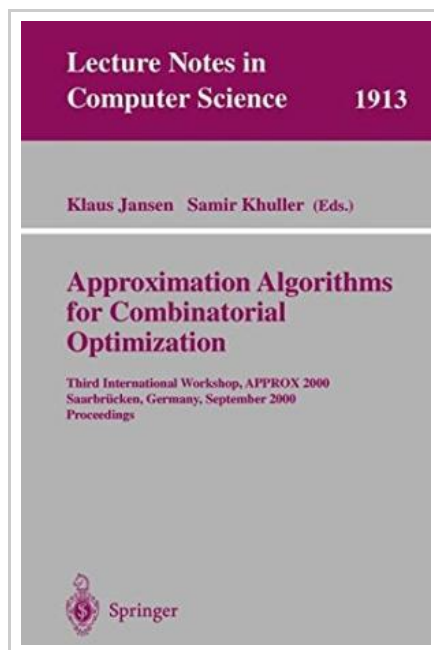

The Workshop on Approximation Algorithms for Combinatorial Optimization Problems APPROX2000 focuses on algorithmic and complexity aspects arising in the development of efficient approximate solutions to computationally difficult problems. It aims, in particular, at fostering cooperation among algorithmic and complexity researchers in the field. The workshop, to be held at the Max-Planck-Institute for Computer Science in Saarbrücken, Germany, co-locates with ESA2020 and WOE2000. We would like to thank the local organizers at the Max-Planck-Institute (AG 8, Kurt Mehlhorn), for this opportunity. APPROX is an annual meeting, with previous workshops in Aalborg and Berkeley. Previous proceedings appeared as LNCS 1464 and 1671. Topics of interest for APPROX2000 are: design and analysis of approximation algorithms, inapproximability results, on-line problems, randomization techniques, average-case analysis, approximation classes, scheduling problems, routing and flow problems, coloring and partitioning, cuts and connectivity, packing and covering, geometric problems, network design, and various applications. The number of submitted papers to APPROX2000 was 68 from which 23 papers were selected. This volume contains the selected papers plus papers by invited speakers. All papers published in the workshop

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
