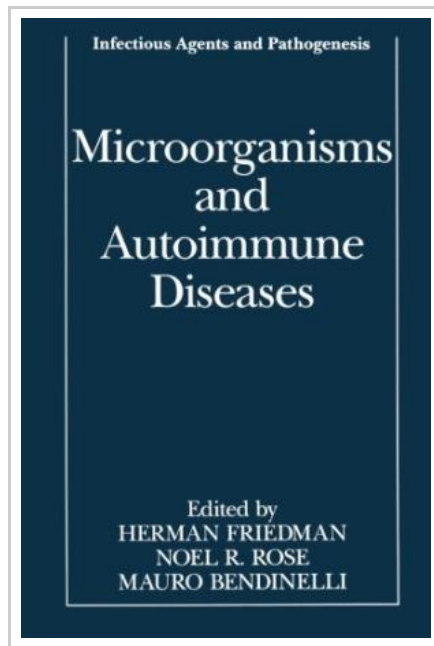




Microorganisms and Autoimmune Diseases
