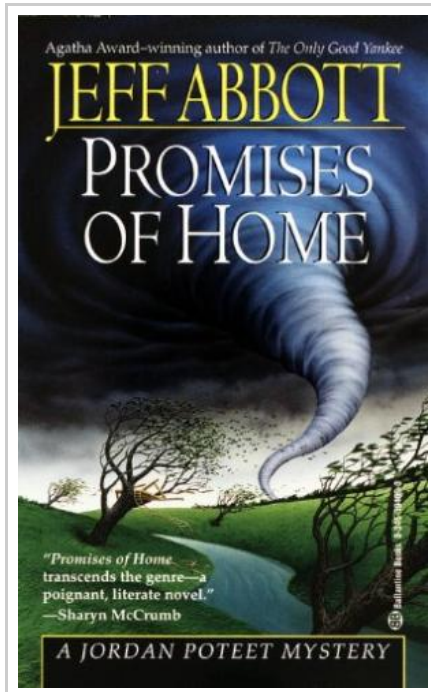




Promises of Home (Paperback)
