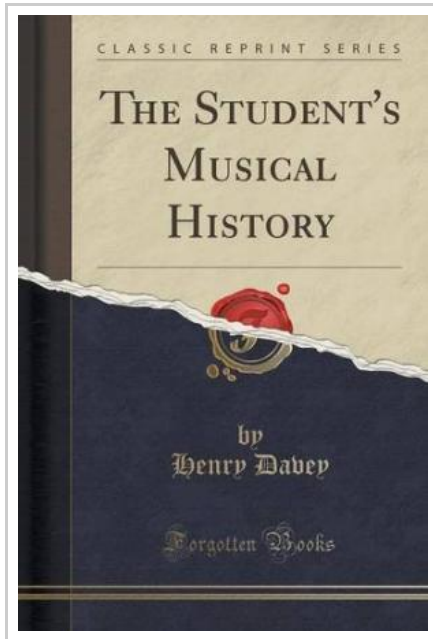




The Student's Musical History (Classic Reprint) (Paperback)

In that article I had pointed out how ignorance of musical history sometimes has a considerable influence upon various practical matters; and, since musicians almost universally suppose that with which they are familiar to be correct and classical, it is well that they should learn in their student-days how notation, style of performance, and resources at command, have varied considerably even during the last two centuries. To perform the works of the great masters correctly, it is not sufficient to produce the correct notes. Again, in the Bach-Handel period, notation was in some respects so different from the present staff notation that it has led to mistakes in certain modern editions. In writing this book, especially in the later chapters, I have laid stress on the fact that good work has been done only by those composers who have boldly attempted to be original, who have used untried resources or invented new...
