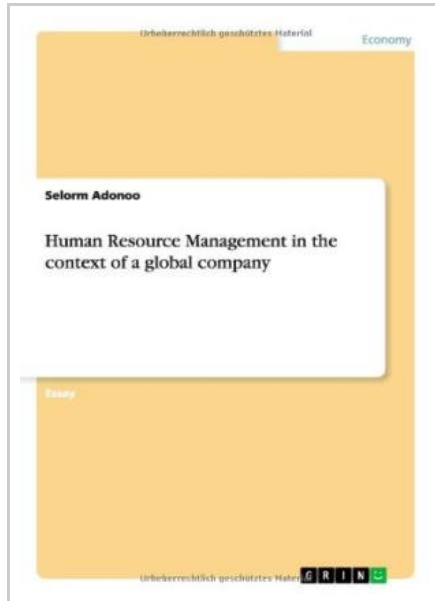




Human Resource Management in the Context of a Global Company
